UNIFORM

Girls—Summer

- ◆ Dress: Checked, pleated tunic in school colours
- ◆ Socks: White, worn just above the ankle

Girls—Winter

- ◆ Shirt: White, long sleeved
- ◆ Tunic: School check, princess style
- ◆ Tie: School check
- ◆ Socks/Tights: Grey knee high or grey tights

Girls/Boys—Sport

- ◆ T Shirt: White polo style with school crest
- ◆ Shorts: Maroon shorts with OLHC
- ◆ Socks: White, worn just above the ankle
- ◆ Tracksuit: Maroon with white stripes, zipper jacket with school crest
- ◆ Shoes: Predominantly **white** lace up joggers (white laces)
- ◆ Polo Shirt: Plain colour polo (no logos) in your child's house colour. (To be worn on carnival days only)

Girls/Boys—Other

- ◆ Jumper/Sloppy Joe: Maroon "V" neck with school crest
- ◆ Hat: Maroon with school crest and brim
- ◆ Wet Weather: Raincoat
- ◆ Shoes: Black leather

Boys—Summer

- ◆ Shirt: Blue short sleeved with crest (Boys in Years 2-6 may wear white short sleeved shirt with crest on pocket)
- ◆ Shorts: Grey, half elastic back
- ◆ Socks: Grey, worn just above the ankle

Boys—Winter

- ◆ Shirt: White, long sleeve with crest on pocket
- ◆ Trousers: Grey with half elastic back
- ◆ Tie: School check
- ◆ Socks: Grey, worn just above the ankle

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HOW TO WEAR YOUR UNIFORM

Every family enrolling students at OLHC receives a uniform list. Here's how to wear it!!

General

- ▶ Students must wear full uniform to school every day.
- ▶ All uniform items should be clean, in good repair and wrinkle free.
- ▶ Names are to be marked on all items of clothing.
- ▶ Full uniform, including hat, to be worn when appearing in public.
- ▶ Boys' school shirts must be tucked in
- ▶ Sports shirts are worn over shorts
- ▶ No brand names to be seen on any part of the uniform
- ▶ The jumper is the first item for warmth. Outer maroon jackets (Parkas) may be worn but must be removed when in the classroom.
- ▶ The uniform is to be worn in such a way as to invite positive comment only
- ▶ Umbrellas do not form part of the uniform policy and are not to be used at school



The School Hat



- ▶ Must be worn to and from school each day and when students are attending excursions or school activities, unless directed otherwise.
- ▶ Hair should be styled so that the hat sits properly on the student's head.
- ▶ **NO HAT, NO PLAY.**

Hair



- ▶ The emphasis is on "neat" and "tidy".
- ▶ Girls hair below the shoulder is to be tied back
- ▶ Girls may wear hair accessories to match the uniform
- ▶ Boys' hair is to be no longer than collar length
- ▶ Extremes of hair cuts are not permitted—hair must be evenly cut—no rat's tails
- ▶ Colouring of hair is not permitted

Socks



- ▶ Girls—Summer and Sport: Worn just above the ankle.
- ▶ Girls—Winter: If wearing socks, pulled to just below the knee
- ▶ Boys—Sport: Worn just above the ankle
- ▶ Boys—Summer and Winter: Worn just above the ankle
- ▶ NO anklet socks—no brand names

Shoes



- ▶ Summer and Winter: Plain, standard black leather, low heels—No deck shoes or boots.
- ▶ Sport: Predominantly white joggers that finish below the ankle (no basketball or slip on styles) with white laces only

School Badge

- ▶ Should be worn on the right hand side collar of shirt or tunic
- ▶ Students new to the school will receive a badge at the Beginning of School Year Mass.
- ▶ Is available for purchase from the office for \$5.00, if badges are lost.

Jewellery—Make Up



- ▶ Small silver or gold studs (without a stone) /sleepers (small only that can twist fully through an ear).
- ▶ Piercings to be on girls only—one piercing on the ear lobe only
- ▶ Small watches may be worn but no "loud" coloured straps/bands so as not to draw attention to them
- ▶ Religious medal on a thin chain (no leather). Chain to be tucked under shirt.
- ▶ Rings and bracelets, of any description, may not be worn
- ▶ No make up of any description is to be worn—this includes nail polish

Sports Uniform

- ▶ To be worn to and from school on the two days designated by the class teacher
- ▶ On carnival days—Cross Country, Athletics and Swimming your child's house colour polo shirt may be worn in place of the normal sport shirt.

Trousers for Girls

Trousers can no longer be purchased for girls. When representing the school, tunics must be worn eg. Choir.
